

# Construction 1: The Golden Cut

find the Golden  
cut of the line  
segment AB.  
(We will find the point closest to B)



# Construction 1: The Golden Cut

1. find the midpoint of AB.


- Draw an arc from A of some radius  $r$ .

- Draw an arc from B of the same radius  $r$ .

- Join the intersections of these two arcs.


- Join the intersections of these two arcs.

This line meets  
AB at M, the  
midpoint.



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2. find the perpendicular at B
- Extend the line segment AB beyond B.
  - Draw a circle about B.
  - find the perpendicular bisector of the two points on the circle that are also on the line.




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3. find D

- Place center of compass at B


and open to point M

- Draw an arc that  
meets the perpendicular  
to AB at B. It meets  
in the point D




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4. Draw the line  
joining A to D.



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
5. find the point E
  - Center the compass at D and open to B.
  - draw arc until it meets the line AD at E.



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6. find C

- center compass at A  
open to E , and  
arc down until  
it meets line  
AB at a point C



$C$  is the desired  
Golden Cut.
