List of Strategies

- Simplify first.
- 2 Look for an obvious substitution.
- Classify the integrand (is it trigonometric, a rational function, does it have a radical, or will it require integration by parts?)
 - Sometimes more than one method is required.
 - ② Careful: sometimes it looks like you need a method but something simpler such as substitution will work.
- Try again.
 - Don't be afraid to try several things that don't work.
 - Sometimes you need more than one technique.
 - 3 In real life, maybe you can't solve the problem at all.
- Practice.
 - 1 There is no substitute for trying hard on many problems.
 - 2 Don't look at the solutions until you're done.
